

V spomin doc. dr. Slavici GOLC TEGER (1948–2011)



Od naše sodelavke in članice uredniškega odbora AAS, docentke dr. Slavice Golc-Teger smo se na ljubljanskih Žalah poslovili 29. septembra 2011. Slavica je bila ves čas svoje poklicne kariere zaposlena v laboratoriju za mlekarstvo Oddelka za zootehniko Biotehniške fakultete. Po osnovni izobrazbi živilska tehnologinja, je magistrirala in doktorirala na področju živilskih znanosti in se posvetila vodenju in razvoju laboratorija za mlekarstvo na Oddelku za zootehniko. Laboratorij je formalno vodila več kot 25 let, z njim rasla in zanj živela. Laboratorij je postal ena od osrednjih strokovnih inštitucij v živinoreji in živilstvu v Sloveniji in širši regiji in je bil pogosto celo

bolj prepoznaven v mednarodnem kot v domačem okolju. Slavica je s svojim strokovnim ugledom pomembno doprinesla k mednarodni akreditaciji laboratorija. Ob številnih projektih, sodelovanju v pedagoškem procesu in aktivnem delu v strokovnih telesih doma in v tujini, je posebej pomembno njeno delovanje v Mednarodnem mlekarskem združenju (IDF), Mednarodnem združenju vodij mlekarskih laboratorijev (INTERLAB) in v delovni skupini za higieno mleka v alpskih deželah AFEMA. V tujini je bila prava ambasadorica slovenskega mlekarstva, še posebej pa si je prizadevala za razvoj analitike mleka in mlečnih izdelkov v državah nekdanje Jugoslavije.

Assist. Prof. Slavica GOLC TEGER, Ph.D. (1948–2011)

Doc. dr. Slavica Golc-Teger a member of the editorial board of AAS was buried on Ljubljana cemetery Žale on September 29, 2011. Slavica spent her entire professional career in the Dairy Laboratory at the Department of Animal Science, Biotechnical Faculty. By training food technologist, she received her MSc and PhD in the field of food sciences and dedicated her efforts to the development of the laboratory, which became one of the central

institutions in the field of animal production and food processing in Slovenia, also internationally well recognized. Slavica contributed importantly with her professional authority to the international accreditation of the laboratory. In addition to her involvement in research and teaching activities, she was very active in different working bodies of national and international professional organisations, especially in the International Dairy Federation (IDF), International association of managers of dairy laboratories (INTERLAB) and in the working group for milk hygiene in Alpine countries AFEMA. Slavica was a real ambassador of Slovenian dairy science. She contributed considerably to the development of dairy laboratories on the territory of the former Yugoslavia.
